LICENSE TO CARRY FIREARMS - FIREARMS IDENTIFICATION CARD NEW AND RENEWAL APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Submit a completed application form. Complete all required information. Blank fields and incomplete applications will delay or prevent issuance.
- 2. Submit a non-refundable application fee of \$100.00 with your application. Payment must be in the form of a personal check, money order or cashier's check. No cash will be accepted
- 3. Read and sign the "Acknowledgment of Limits on the Use of Deadly Force" form and submit with your application.
- 4. First time LTC and FID applicants are required to take a state-certified basic firearms safety course with the exception of FID cards issued solely for chemical spray. If you plan on applying for a state hunting license, it is recommended that you take the state hunter safety course. This course satisfies the LTC, FID and hunting license requirements.
- 5. First time applicants must submit three letters of reference from persons willing to be contacted by the licensing authority. Letters must be original and signed by the reference. Photo copies, form letters and unsigned reference letters will not be accepted. References must provide current contact information or the reference will not be considered. This will delay or prevent issuance.
- 6. Officers or employees of the Northborough Police Department are prohibited from providing reference letter for applicants applying in Northborough.
- 7. Contact Records / Licensing Supervisor, Chris Carleton, one week after submitting application for review.
- 8. LTC and FID cards expire on your birthday and are valid for not more than six years from issuance.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: The E-FA-10 is now the Massachusetts Gun Portal. Firearms licensees and gun owners are required by law to report ALL private sales, transfers, and surrenders of firearms to the Massachusetts Firearms Records Bureau via the Gun Portal. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF LIMITS ON THE USE OF DEADLY FORCE

In accordance with the authority granted by Mass General Laws, Chapter 140 S131, the licensing authority of the Town of Northborough has determined that every licensee shall be familiar with the legal limits on the use of deadly force under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. Accordingly, all such applicants are required to read this memorandum and sign below certifying that they have read it. The applicant or licensee shall be given a copy of the memorandum at no charge.

I. DEADLY FORCE BY CITIZEN IN ARRESTING A FELON

The use of deadly force is not justified unless 1) the arrest is for a felony and 2) the person effecting the arrest is authorized to act as a peace officer or is assisting a person whom he believes to be authorized to act as a peace officer and 3) the actor reasonably believes that the force employed creates no substantial risk to innocent persons; and 4) The actor reasonably believes that (a) the crime for which the arrest is made involved conduct including the use or threatened use of deadly force; and (b) there is a substantial risk that the person to be arrested will cause death or serious bodily harm if his apprehension is delayed.

II. DEADLY FORCE IN SELF-DEFENSE OR DEFENSE OF OTHERS

A. General Rule

Before a person may resort to deadly force he must 1) have reasonable grounds to believe and actually believe that he is in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury harm, from which he can save himself only be using deadly force. 2) avail himself of all proper means to avoid physical combat before resorting to the use of deadly force, and 3? Use no more force than is reasonably necessary in all circumstances.

B. Aiding a Third Party

A person may resort to deadly force to aid a third party when (a) a reasonable person in the actor's position believes that it is necessary to intervene to protect the third party and (b) in the circumstances as that reasonable person would believe them to be, the third party would be justified in using deadly force to protect himself. The reasonableness of the belief may depend in part of the relationship between the parties.

C. In a Dwelling House

In the prosecution of a person who is an occupant of a dwelling charged with killing or injuring one who was unlawfully in said dwelling, it shall be a defense that the occupant was in his dwelling at the time of the offense and that he acted in the reasonable belief that the person unlawfully in said dwelling was about to inflict great bodily injury or death upon said occupant or upon another person lawfully in said dwelling and that said dwelling. There shall be no duty on said occupant to retreat from such person unlawfully in said dwelling.
