The FBI Law Enforcement Executive Development Association (FBI-LEEDA) is the premier executive law enforcement continuing education provider for public safety leaders. FBI-LEEDA is dedicated to advancing law enforcement leadership through premier training, education, and networking.





LEEDA COMMAND LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE (CLI)

This month, **Sergeants Montville**, **McDonald and Trefry** attended the LEEDA Command Leadership Institute (CLI). The CLI is part two of the three-step leadership series that makes up the FBI-LEEDA Trilogy.

The CLI provides real-life, contemporary, best-practice strategies and techniques for those who are already commanders or are aspiring to a command level assignment. CLI students engage in such topics as: credibility, command discipline, liability, problem employees, and leading change within an organization.

The FBI-LEEDA Trilogy series is comprised of three 4 ½ day courses:

- Supervisor Leadership Institute (SLI): Focuses on the transition to first-line supervision, emphasizing credibility, liability, and foundational leadership philosophies.
- **Command Leadership Institute (CLI):** Prepares organizational leaders to build effective teams, manage challenging personnel, and address ethical and strategic decision-making.
- Executive Leadership Institute (ELI): Designed for enterprise leaders, addressing community policing, diversity, future trends, and emotional intelligence

Sergeant Trefry and Sergeant McDonald have now each completed 2 of the 3 courses. Sergeant Montville has completed all 3 and will be receiving the LEEDA Trilogy Award.
